You will be receiving a comprehensive eye exam today. The doctor will examine your eyes for many medical eye conditions such as glaucoma, dry eyes, pink eye, cataracts, retinal holes or tears, diabetic, arteriolar sclerotic, and hypertensive eye disease among many others. Many of these conditions have no effect on your sight and cause no pain in the early stages. Dr. DeConcilis and Dr. Mowl are committed to giving you the highest quality eye care which is why they perform such a thorough exam.

However, it is important that you understand that your Vision Plan covers ROUTINE eye care only (i.e. nearsightedness, farsightedness, and normal astigmatism). It is NOT a medical insurance plan. It will NOT PAY for eye exams that involve eye diseases. If Dr. DeConcilis or Dr. Mowl discover a medical condition related to your eyes that require specific counseling, documentation, follow-up care, regular monitoring visits, or referral to a surgeon, then your visit is NOT COVERED by your Vision Plan. Unfortunately, the doctor cannot tell if a medical condition exists before you are thoroughly examined.

Professional Medical fees are NOT COVERED by your Vision Plan. If any medical services are rendered today, your medical insurance will be billed. You will be responsible for any co-pays or deductibles specific to your medical plan. Failure of the doctor to abide by the above conditions may result in his or her removal from the Vision Plan or Medical Insurance Plan panel.
