

Our office has a new state of the art instrument that provides our doctors with a full image of the central retina and its structures (the optic nerve, macula, and main blood stream vessels). There is normal variation in these eye structures from person to person and it is good to have a record of each individual patient's eyes.

In some patients, these images may detect undiagnosed eye disease. Many eye diseases cause slow structural changes over time. Therefore, a reference image allows your doctor to more accurately identify changes in your eye structures and treat diseases at an early stage. Early diagnosis can reduce the risk of visual complications.
